This day the Cause came to be again heard on the papers formerly
read, and the Report of J. A. Chamberlain, who was ordered by a decree of
the Court at New Haven 1871, to foot certain Deposits, Stock & Bonds
in said Court, and was agreed by Counsel, on Consideration shown
he should file his report, to which no exception has been
filed, and said judge, before he does, let the Registered Bond of
the State of Virginia, dated July 15 1871, for the amount of \$1000
payable to J. A. Chamberlain, Commissioner, Suffolker County
in suit of Orgain v. Payson &c. be filed together with his
Report, wherein be the papers of this County, and that Anne M.
Orgain, Mrs. Stark, be and she is authorized to receive any
amount interest shown during her life on the Court date further
decrees that another Bond of same date in amount remains in
the papers of this Cause, and that Elizabeth Carter Orgain
now Hartman wife of Charles Hartman receives the annual interest
thereon during the lifetime of the said Elizabeth.

And the Court doth further decree that a Certificate for \$533.33
dated July 15 1871, payable to J. A. Chamberlain, Commissioner &c.
remain in the papers of this Court, the annual interest to
which may be received by Mary M. Stark during her lifetime
and the same date further added that a similar Certificate filed in the
papers of this Court remains in the papers the annual interest
which may be collected by Elizabeth C. Morrison during her life -
And the Court doth further decree that the Clerk of this Court deliver to
Mary M. Stark, formerly Orgain, & to her Credit, the sum of
one thousand and one hundred and one dollars and one cent
(\$1001.01) and the same date for which the same is payable
to J. A. Chamberlain, Commissioner &c. who is directed to file the
same for the sum given in Court for the amount of the
former certain sum, or payment of his Commission for
judging the above sum, & to do & to the Clerk and
report to this Court the Clerk will take receipt from the parties to
the Bonds so called & to be delivered to them, and file with the papers of
this cause.
