This day the Cause came on to be again heard at the papers formally
read, and the Report of J. R. Charnock, who was ordered by a decree of
this Court at this Court 1871, to find certain Virginia Stockholders
in their debt, and was argued by Counsel, as considered and affirmed
the Court still confirms said report, to which no exceptions they had
filed, and did approve, but did order, that the Registered Book of

which may be received by Mary C. Ogaine during her lifetime
and the Court doth further order that a similar Certificate filed in the
papers of this Cause remain in the papers of the amount thereof to
which may be collected by Elizabeth C. Harrison during her life.
And the Court doth further order that the Clerk of this Court deliver to
Mary C. Ogaine, formerly Ogaine, or to her heirs, the Company Book
of 1871, and of 1872 and Certificate for \$33.33 dated July 1st 1871, payable to
J. R. Charnock, Commissioner of - to which they are entitled in
- and the Court doth further decree that the Clerk of this
Court deliver to J. R. Charnock, Commissioner of - the same Book of 1871, and
of 1872, and the Certificate for \$33.33 dated July 1st 1871, payable to
J. R. Charnock, Commissioner of - who is directed to place the
same for the said parties in the Court records, and out of the
proceeds return fees in payment of his Commission for
finding the same during under a decree of this Court, and
report to this Court the Book with the receipts from the parties for
the same ordered to be delivered to them, and file with the papers of
this Cause.

And the Court doth further decree, that the Clerk of the Court
deliver to Charles Harrison and Elizabeth C. Ogaine, or to their heirs,
the Company Book of 1871 and 1872, and Certificate for \$33.33 dated
July 1st 1871 payable to J. R. Charnock, Commissioner of - to which they
are entitled in fee.
