did adjudge order and decree that the change of investment be prayed for in the plaintiffs bill be
authorized and allowed; and it being suggested to the Court that Chas. C. Wright desired to purchase
the tract of land that is now held by J. J. Kincaid as trustee for the benefit of the wife and
children of C. C. Dardur, and it being to pay the purchase money, to wit the sum of Eight hundred
dollars, the Court did further decree that upon the receipt of the said purchase money, the said

the same; and it being also suggested to the Court, that the desired to be purchased by the
Commissioners in the village of Jerusalem is owned by Chas. C. Wright, the Court did further

of land, in the purchase of said lot, not buildings, take a deed therefor with special warranty
from the said Wright, upon the same trusts and limitations as the deed conveying the said parcel
of land contained, and make report to Court, in order to a final decree.
