 The day the court came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read and on the reports of Commissioner H. H. Briggs of the sale of the real estate made under a decree of the County Court of Southampton at January term 1872, and of the Commission of Sale made under a decree of said Court at March term 1872, and was argued by counsel on consideration thereof the Court did refuse said report, to admit no receipt was brought - and it being ordered that the claim due to R.
