 Twenty five cents, to Georgiana Jones the sum of four dollars and Twenty five cents;
 that the Clerk doth further direct, that until David D. Jones, Rev. Dr. Sibley and
 Wm H. Jones shall each before the 10th day of December 1854, pay to Wm H.
 Jones and Mary Jones his wife the sum of One hundred and Fifty dollars, to
 Rev. Dr. Sibley the sum of One hundred and Fifty dollars, in the lawful
 Guardian of Georgiana Jones the like sum of One hundred and Fifty dollars, then
 Joseph C. Pease who is lawfully appointed a Special Commissioner for that purpose,
 shall after having given at least Twenty five Dollars of the sum so paid
 by him, by just and equal instalments, taking from the principal
 sum with approved economy, interest from the day of his last and returning
 the same until the further sum of this sum and return the said sum to the
 Court, along with his Report in order to a further decree. But the said Joseph C.
 Pease shall not proceed to act under this decree until he shall have received
 in the Clerk's Office of this Court, a sum to the parity of One thousand
 dollars, conditioned for a faithful performance of this decree, and for other
 which may be entered in this cause.
