suit in said Court, and the said Court shall give to the said Clerk Mr. Bishop a discharge and receipt in favor  
of the Judgment obtained in November 1857 by James T. Butts Esquire of  
Edward Butts vs John M. Gurley and others H. Bishop for the sum of  
one hundred & forty five dollars & twenty four cents that until the  
said Clerk H. Bishop shall pay the above named sum of  $\$100$ . & cts and  
cost to the said General Court within three months from the date of this  
decrees, then the decree shall be void and of no effect.

To Bishop who has fit himself and all other conditions of  
satisfaction at your door. Gepp.

It being bargained & concluded that E. R. Story the Superintendent in this State has and  
will hold Melle T. Story his widow his qualified as his Administrator over the  
Matters of the said Melle T. Story administration of E. R. Story and it is ordered  
that this cause be proceeded with in the Court, and that they the Court  
cause to be further heard on the papers formerly read and its report of  
Commissioner Taylor filed September 10<sup>th</sup> 1878, as was argued by Counsel  
on Consideration among the Court Conference, Side Report, the Plaintiffs being  
permitted to the same, Clerk affixing, before the decree, that Geo. C. Weston Esq.  
of Atlanta & Jones pay to Melle T. Story widow of E. R. Story the sum  
of Fifty four  $\frac{1}{2}$  less  $\$100$  dollars (the sum being balance due from Miss Read  
to the estate of E. R. Story,) in part satisfaction of debt due E. R.  
Story by said A. Jones and others and the Court will further direct  
that Melle T. Story & Weston to have one for her, shall apply to the  
Court from the credit paid to the said Melle T. Story Administrator  
of E. R. Story the sum of Sixty dollars and eighteen cents (sum being  
balance due E. R. Story by Melle T. Jones,) with interest thereon from  
Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> 1873, till paid and also the costs of this suit, then W.  
W. Bridge Sheriff of Muskingum County, is directed to take sufficient  
of the real estate owned by Melle T. Jones debt unpaid, and sell the  
same in four years & years until the whole debt of  $\$100$ . & cts with  
interest as aforesaid and costs of this suit are fully paid, and the  
revenue of the said Law States be after twenty days published Notice, to  
party owing to give them quiet and good security in the night to  
plaintiff being satisfied, And the Court further directs that Geo. C.  
Weston to have full copy of this Order and also W. W.  
Bridge make reply to Court of his proceeding under  
this Order.
