such, General Representative as aforesaid by Commissioner Taylor Report of the  
30<sup>th</sup> of Oct 1871 with interest thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1872, he  
paid, and the Court doth adjudge Order and decree, that the said John  
Kelly Esq. as aforesaid, out of the proceeds of Bank of the Bank of  
Cayuga and Johnson, O'Leary as he may collect over the sum of \$300.00 to be paid  
as aforesaid by the Report above referred to, and the above aforesaid directed  
handed to be paid to him by Samuel Kelly Committee representative of John  
Bramfield Esq. and pay any costs that may remain unpaid, and then for
