This day has come to be finished? heard at the papers forming  
part of the Affidavit of Councillor Miles Long late  
May 15<sup>th</sup> and was argued by Counsel Dr. Cresson et al.  
whereby the said Councillor made Report to uphold the Complaint  
thus was filed, was argued, tested and decided that Plaintiff  
to the said late Parker according to the administration of  
said Plaintiff at the office of Miles Long late  
did so account showing the balance due to the respective  
holders of all for Long debts which accounts the said  
Councillor also reported to Court wrote on 24<sup>th</sup> after  
Specially States, being paid by Plaintiff, and  
required to be so stated.

This came to be again heard in the papers forming  
part of the Affidavit of John Kelly Councillor made previous to the  
decree of July 15<sup>th</sup> to which Report there is no exception and was agreed  
by Counsel Dr. Cresson whereby the said Clerk of the said  
Report and with signature, tested and decided, that the said John  
Kelly Councillor as aforesaid, forced to pay of H. Johnson  
Johnson's estimate the sum of the sum of \$244.17 which was  
paid on 19<sup>th</sup> of July 1870, on which it appears by said Report that  
was sum made for payment of \$100 each and also received of the  
Clerk of the said Clerk (who will deliver) the same to him on his  
leaving the Receipt therefor the remaining two sums of  
Johnson Johnson & others of \$100 each due respectively  
the 19<sup>th</sup> of July 1874 and the 19<sup>th</sup> of July 1875 on account of  
therefore as per the Receipt to pay the unpaid debts due of  
the said John Crumpler alias as and named in (Councillor)  
Teller Reports of 30<sup>th</sup> October 1871 and 28<sup>th</sup> of October  
1873 and 2d<sup>nd</sup> April by said Kelly Councillor as  
aforesaid, and Miles' Report to Committee
