This day the Cause came on to be heard. Read at the papers forming
part and on the Report of Commissioner John M. Keiser & dec'd of
May Term 1870 and was argued by Counsel for Appellations

Keiser Commissioner as aforesaid, proceed to collect of George James
Schmidt & others the balance of the debt of \$2000.00 which was

said John M. Keiser has paid of \$1000 each and also received of the
estate of this Court (who also deliver) the same to him on the
14th day of July 1870 (the receipt therefore) the remaining two parts of
George James Schmidt others of \$1000.00 each due respectively
the 14th day 1870 and the 14th of July 1870 and collect as money
thereof as much as necessary to pay the unpaid debt due of
the said John Keiser dec'd. as and named in Commissioner
John M. Keiser's Report of 20th October 1870 and 20th of October
1870 and not paid by said John Keiser, Commissioner as
aforesaid, and make Report to Court.
