 Order and decree, That Elliott L. Story Esq. of Daniel W.
 Both doth deposit in the Petersburg Savings & Insurance Company
 the sum of \$3000 taking a Certificate payable to himself as
 Esq. of said J. W. Both doth and file the Certificate among
 the papers of other Cases, subject to the further Order &
 the Court. And the Court doth further adjudge, Order and
 decree, That Elliott L. Story settle a final account of his
 transactions as Executor of Daniel W. Both before one of the
 Commissioners of this Court who shall Report the same
 together with any matters specially stated, which may
 be deemed pertinent by himself or which may be
 required to be so stated, by any of the parties interested?
