This day this Cause came on again to be heard in the proper form, read and the report of Commissioner Tyler made pursuant to a decree of this Court entered at the June Term 1874, and as to which report no exceptions have been filed and was argued by Counsel, to the Court wherein the Court doth further adjudge, Order and decree, that the said report be confirmed, and by appearing to the Court from the said report, that the sum of the Defendant's damages shall be paid and the Judgment against him reported as such, and the Court doth further adjudge, Order and decree, that the Sheriff of Southampton shall not annually at public auction to the highest bidder, the tract of land containing eighty-eight (88) acres, taking from the said land one good penny every year until the debt is paid, the sum of twenty thousand pounds and the cost with the interest thereon and paid, and all the costs of this suit which the Plaintiff has incurred, and the Court doth further Order that the Sheriff report his proceedings in this Cause, annually to the Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning nine o'clock.
