This cause came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read and on the report of J. H. Briggs, Commissioner made pursuant to the decree made in said cause of the 10th of October Term of this Court - to which report there is no exception, and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth confirm the said report - and it appearing to the Court that in said decree of October Term 1871 there is a clerical error in directing said Briggs to pay out the sum of one hundred and seventy six dollars, (the original directing the payment of one dollar and seventy six cents) it is ordered that such error be and the same is hereby corrected, and that said Briggs account for one dollar and seventy six cents as in said decree directed, and it is further ordered that the said J. H. Briggs' Commissioner aforesaid receive of the Clerk of this Court the two unpaid Bonds of J. M. Carter and George C. Carter of three hundred and twenty five dollars due respectively the 15th of December 1871 and 15th Decr. 1876 and return the same when due, or before due of the said Decr. 1872 Carter and George C. Carter ¹⁸⁷² to pay the same in whole or in part to Court when paid, and each of the two said payors may enter their own receipt therefor, and the residue (together with the said sum of one dollar and seventy six cents now in said Briggs' hands, fully to James A. Gilbert, Th. A. Bell and Jas. Gilbreath, the sum of five hundred & eighty two dollars with interest on three hundred dollars paid three years from the 1st July 1873 till paid (subject to the payment of one hundred & twenty five dollars as paid on the 19th of April 1875) as appears by said Briggs' report first herein named, and it is further ordered that on the payment by said Th. A. Bell of his Bonds aforesaid, the said J. H. Briggs Commissioner aforesaid is hereby directed to send to said Wm. M. Carter a deed for the same sold under proceedings herein and forthwith by him: and it is further ordered by the Court that the said J. H. Briggs, Commissioner aforesaid, after paying the said debt and costs as above directed shall pay the residue to the Wm. Carter assignee of Wm. M. Carter on account of claim owned by the said of Southsiding referred to in the proceedings as Exhibit B. which assignment will appear by papers filed in this cause, and made report to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow at ten o'clock.
