Demand General Petition Committed of Hertford County v.

This cause came on to be heard at the Complainants bill taken for confined as  
the defendant Gallie P. Greenwells, and others persons had been duly executed and the  
said Petition to appear and make defense, and on the answer of C. G. B. Briggs, genl  
and Clerk of Hertford County doth, with general replication to said bill, doth also  
admit facts with the said Bill and was argued by Counsel. On Consideration  
whereof, the Court doth adjudge, order and direct that a Commissioner of this Court  
proceed to ascertain and report the following accounts. 1<sup>st</sup> all documents of the value of  
the interest (one eighteenth) of Hertford County in the lands referred to in the Bill  
which be obtained by the death of his mother Margaret Greenwell in the County of  
Dare & Rockland dec<sup>d</sup>. 2<sup>nd</sup> An account of all other estate to which said Hertford County  
is intitled. 3<sup>rd</sup> Whether the sale of said one eighteenth of the land as above named,  
would be best for the interest of said Hertford County and invested in other  
estate, and make report to Court of any matter specially stated demand particular by  
parties or that any of the parties may require to be so stated.

to Court as follows. 1<sup>st</sup> The annual price by the sale of the lands of said petitioners, to the  
creditors of said C. G. Longleaf dec<sup>d</sup>. 2<sup>nd</sup> What amount should be contributed to each  
petitioner by each of the other executors of said C. G. Longleaf dec<sup>d</sup> and the fee simple  
and annual value of the land held by the same or the persons of land, and make report  
to Court with any incident specially stated demand particular by him or that any of the  
parties may require to be so stated.
