This day this Cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read, the report of Commissioner Tyler, made pursuant to a decree of this Court, entered at the February Term 1875, and to which report no exceptions have been filed and was approved by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court doth adjudge order & decree that the said report be confirmed, and that the Sheriff of Southampton after having given at least thirty days notice of the time & place of sale by public advertisement at Jerusalem, and Newsums and Boykins, proceed at Jerusalem on some County Court day to sell at public auction to the highest bidder, the following parcels of land and the interest of Benj. B. Kindred therein, to-wit: he did seized & possessed tract of 831 acres in fee simple; Benj. B. Kindred's life estate in 100 acres of land, it being the closer land of Mrs. Chauncey, which he purchased; the said Benj. B. Kindred's interest in 831 acres of land, now held by Mrs. Mary Kindred, his mother, for life it being a reversionary interest in one fifth of the said 831 acres in reversion in fee simple on the following terms: Sufficient cash to pay the costs of this suit and the balance of the purchase money, on a credit of one, two and three years, paid annual instalments, taking from the purchaser bonds with approved security, carrying interest from the day of sale, retaining the title to the said land until the further order of this Court; and release the said bonds to Court along with his report of his proceedings. And the Court doth further adjudge order & decree that a Commissioner of this Court, take a further administration account of Benj. B. Kindred's estate, also take a further account of debts outstanding against the said estate, and report the said accounts to Court, together with any other matter specially stated deemed pertinent by himself, or which shall be required to be so stated by any of the parties interested.
