This came out again heard, and the papers formerly read together with the Report of William Spinner before this day filed by order of Court, and the Court, confirming said Report doth adjudge, order and decree that Samuel D. Hammond Executor of Daniel Leath deceased pay now to the legally appointed guardian of Sarah Susan Leath minor child of the said Daniel Leath deceased, out of any monies in his hands belonging to the estate of said deceased the sum of one hundred and forty five Dollars - That the said Executor forward to Clark the bond due to said estate from Mill C. Gaughey within, and pay the same together with the whole of the balance of said deceased's personal estate now in his hands according to said Report to the legally appointed guardians of Ann Maria Virginia Leath minor child of said deceased - That the said Henry Chambliss and the children of Nancy Chambliss deceased (formerly wife of Henry Chambliss, and daughter of the said Daniel Leath dec'd) to wit: Joseph E.
