This day the Court came on to be further heard on the papers formerly by case, the report of Commission, Order and Affidavits, filed hereto, signed and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court conforming said report to which there is no exception, with adjudge, order and decree that writs of Relief be, that said R. H. Hurdley shall pay to the personal representative of Henderson Broadhead & Co. within thirty days from this date the sum of three hundred and eighty dollars, with interest on the hundred dollars, from the date of said writs, at the rate of six per cent. per annum, and the interest of said writs in the hands of his assignee, J. H. Hurdley, till the interest of said writs is paid, when said R. H. Hurdley shall at public auction, at the Court House of this County, upon some County Court day, after advertising same for twenty days by public notice in three or more public places, where following terms, enough cash to pay expenses of said auction - balance in cash of one, two and three years, equal annual installments the purchaser to give back each approved security, including interest from date and till returned for deferred payments. And the said J. H. Hurdley will make report to Court of his proceedings.
