(This day) this cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioner Taylor filed September 30th 1876, and was argued by Counsel, on consideration whereof the Court doth Conform said report, in exception being filed thereto, and it appearing to the Court that the same and profits of the said estate belonging to the defendant H. B. French will pay the judgment herein against him in five years, the Court doth accordingly order and decree, that unless the said French or some one for him, shall within forty days from this date pay to Francis & Son, of New York with interest up to December first three thousand dollars, due for rent, till paid, and to add, millions of M. & H. with interest on \$46,500 paid thereon from 25th January 1876, and to send the sum of \$8,400 with interest on \$5,000 paid thereon from January 1st 1876, there shall be W. W. Briggs Sheriff of Northampton take possession of the said estate belonging to said French and rent the same out for one year to the highest bidder thereof, after giving ten days notice of the auctioning at some or more public places in this County, that he take from the rents paid with approved security, payable December 1st 1877, and reserves the right to distrain for the rents, if it is not paid or is before said 1st December 1877, and make report to Court.
