This day this cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioner Tyler, filed September 20th 1876, and was argued by Counsel, on Consideration whereof, the Court doth find and certify its report, in substance being filed thereto, and it appearing to the Court that the rents and profits of the said estate belonging to the defendant, Wm. B. Gandy will pay the judgment being against him in few years, the Court doth adjudge, order and decree, that unless the said Gandy is done law for same, please appearing forty days from this date pay to Francis & Bro, \$100.13 with interest at 6% per cent thereof from 2^d Dec 1876, till paid, and to Geo. Williams \$49.24 with interest at 6% per cent thereof from 2^d January 1876, and to same the sum of \$100.00 with interest at 6% per cent thereof from Jan 1st 1876, then due to, George Shewitt & Son as a debt due to possession of the said estate belonging to said Gandy and rent the same out for one year to the highest bidder therefor, after giving ten days notice of the auctioning at some or more public places in this County, that he take from the renter Bond with approved security, payable December 1st 1877, and reserve the right to disclaim for the same, if it is not paid on or before said 1st December 1877, and make report to Court.
