This Cause came on the 12th day to be again heard on the papers formerly
sent in and on the Report of Mr. Rogers shortly on Commission and of
Mr. Weymouth's Commission. Made pursuant to a decree of the Court, at
its sitting June 15th, 1876, which reports on transcripts and filed, and on application
with the Court filed March 21st, 1878, and was argued by Counsel, the Court did then
whereby, the Court doth confirm said Report and doth further, adjudge,
order and decree, that unless the said Robert Hilday and wife, or some one
for them, should within the next sixty days pay to your petitioner J. W.
Weymouth, Clerk Weymouth, J. W. Weymouth the sum of \$1767.73, then
founder and satisfy his said debt, with interest at 8% per annum from
March 21st, 1878, that then the said J. W. Weymouth, Commissioner
shall proceed to sell at public auction, in said County, some day, before
the Court house door, in January, at the request of the said decedent to say

decree of the Court at its sittings June 15th, 1876, as the said debt of Robert
Hilday and wife, as may be appearing to pay the claim against said
Robert Hilday and wife and that before said day shall be made, the
same shall be admitted in said County Court day preceding a day

public place in said County. And the said decree to make forth
following terms, to wit, enough Cash to pay all unpaid costs and the

debts, in equal instalments, bearing 8% per cent, approved security

said said Land until the further order of this Court.
And that the said J. W. Weymouth, Commissioner take possession
of the said land, belonging to Robert Hilday and wife, and proceed to
rent, store and publically or privately, for one year, after a notice of
ten days, at some or more public places in this County, taking
their said approved security payable on the 1st day of January
1878, from the renter waiving, however, exemption, and
reserving the right to discontinue, if the same is not paid
on or before the 1st day of January 1878, and make report
to Court.
