This Case came on to be again heard on the papers formerly
read & the report of J. W. Vergennes Commissioner. We said previously
to a decree of this Court at its December Term
(1875) to which report no exceptions have been filed, and on
an assignment this day filed marked "B" and was
assigned by Counsel. On Consideration whereof the
Court doth confirm said report and doth further adj.
order (and decree) that the said J. W. Vergennes
Commissioner take possession of the lands belonging to
do I and J. K. Vergennes, and proceed to rent them out
privately or publicly for one year after a notice
of twenty days in these or several public places
in this County, taking and giving official security,
payable on the 1st day of January 1877, from the
rents, against all Committed embezzlements and receiving
the right to disclaim if the rent is not paid, on or
before the 1st day of January 1877.
And make report to Court.

And ordered that the Court be adjourned until Tuesday
11th January 1877 at 10 o'clock.
