This cause came and this day to be argued heard on the papers formerly and
and on the report of Commissioner J. D. Wiggin's, made pursuant to a decree
of this Court, at its May Term 1864, to which short no exception was filed and
was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court doth confirm and
adopt and doth further adjudge, order and decree that until the said 6th
June S. R. Wiggin's or some and his heirs shall pay within two months ten
days to your petitioner L. C. Wiggin's, H. H. Wiggin's and A. H.
Wiggin's, the sum of One thousand and seventy seven dollars, and sixteen cents and
interest and five hundred and fifty six and ^{one}/_{two} thirty cents, from and after the day of
May 5th 1864, that there the said J. D. Wiggin's Commissioner shall pro-
ceed to sell at public auction on some County Court day before the Court
have done, in Jerusalem so much of the lands described to the children
of J. D. Wiggin's and described as the lands of L. C. and S. R. Wiggin's
as may be necessary to pay said claim against said L. C. & S. R. Wiggin's.
And that before such sale shall be made, the same shall be advertised in one
County Court day previous to the day of said sale, at the County house and
at an other public place in the County. And the sale shall be made upon
the following terms, to wit: enough cash to pay all unpaid costs and the expenses
of this sale, the balance and a credit of twelve and eighteen months in equal
installments, taking bonds with approved security, from the purchaser, arising
from the stamping and writing titles to said lands until the further order of
the Court and make report to Court.
