This day this Court came on again to be heard on the papers  
formerly read of the Report of James H. Tyley, Comptroller, of 4<sup>th</sup> dist.  
Brigg's administration of W. Kindred's estate, an account of the delin-  
quencies against her estate, & an account of the actual and  
assessed value of all the real estate wherof she died seized and  
proprietor of to which reports on exceptions have been filed and was  
argued by Counsel, the consideration wherof the Court last Sep-  
ember, ordered & decreed that the said Report be confirmed, and  
the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree, that W. W.  
Brigg administrator of the said Lucy W. Kindred dec'd pay to  
Henry B. Kindred the mty Comptroller who has provided a debt of  
\$1107.42, the sum of \$1170.88 that being the balance in his  
hands due the Estate of it appearing to the Court from an examination  
of the said Report that the rents of the 392 acres of Land via mt  
pay the balance of the debt due Henry B. Kindred, in full now.  
it is further decreed & ordered that W. W. Brigg's Sheriff & Undercon-  
ster, who is hereby appointed Comptroller for that purpose, shall  
after having given at least thirty days notice of the time and place of  
sale by public advertisement at Hopkins Depot, at Paines Depot and  
Junction point to all of said places, on some Court Day at  
specified location, to the highest bidder, the tract of 392 acres of  
land wherof Lucy B. Kindred, died seized & proprietor, on the  
following terms to wit, one third cash, the balance in two equal  
annual payments of one and two years, taking from the purchaser  
bids upon approved Security, carrying interest from the day of  
sale, & after paying the expense of this sale, & of the sale, pay  
the balance of the cash payments to Henry B. Kindred, taking  
his receipt therefor, & return all his receipts to the Court to the  
Court along with his Report in order to a further decree.
