This Court came out to be again heard this day, at the proper  
time, & the Report of Commissioner of W. Arguello, made  
pursuant to a decree of this Court at its Term 1874, to which  
Report there are no exceptions filed to this court by Counsel, or Complain-  
ants before the Court doth confirm said Report, & doth adjudge, order  
and decree that of W. Arguello Commissioner receiver of the estate of  
this Court, (who will deliver the same to him in his having &  
receipt thereof,) the two bonds of J. D. Prutton & S. B. Prutton for Two  
Hundred & Thirty dollars each, due respectively the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January  
1878, to the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1879, & dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 1877,  
bearing interest from the 17<sup>th</sup> December 1877, & proceed to collect the same &
