Rutten for Four Hundred & Thirty dollars each, due respectively the 17th day of December 1878, to the 17th day of June 1879, & dated the 18th day of April 1878, bearing interest from the 17th Decr 1877, & proceed to collect the same as they become due, & are entered thereon, & the said parties and at liberty to pay the same before due if they elect) in which said interest is to be paid at the day of payment, & not for the purpose of such bond pay any unpaid Costs & other pay to all all Wigwante & his and heirs & as assignee of J. H. Wigwante, & to W. H. Wigwante & assigns according to the amounts heretofore decreed to be paid to them, the sum of Three hundred & seventy seven & 40/100 dollars with interest on Three hundred & fifty six & 40/100 dollars paid thereof from May 5th 1876; And pay any balance that may remain, after payment of the said debts to all all Wigwante & W. H. Wigwante to the proper Guardian of C. T. & S. R. Wigwante. And when the said bond of J. S. Rutten & S. B. Rutten are fully paid, Make to the said J. S. Rutten, & S. B. Rutten, a writ of Special Warrant in the usual form, for the usual habeas corpus report to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until tomorrow morning Nine O'clock.
