This cause was again held this day on the papers formerly issued, at the 1st of Commissioners Tangleton, Cranfield and Hastings, appointed at the May Term of this Court 1777, to which no exception had been filed to the definition of Defendants. On Consideration whereof the Court Conforming said Report, doth adjudge; for Taylor £2000. On or about the 1st of Sept. being in the Town of Franklin to fully described in the Complaints filed & the Report of said Commissioners, he divided £2000 in two separate and distinct Lots as recommended by said Commissioners in the Town of Franklin, after thirty days Notice to said lots to be published in four or more public places in the County of Gloucester, & in the Franklin Ministry a newspaper published in said Town of Franklin, in the following Terms to wit; One fourth in Cash, the balance to be Credit of one, two & three years, equal instalments, the payment & payment to give Credit for the deferred payments, & to sufficient person bearing the bill to be retained until the further Order of the Court, And for the purpose of executing this decree, R. R. Griffin is appointed a Special Commissioner to sell said lot & land, but he shall not force to sell it, such title he shall have record in the Clerks Office of this Court before the Clerk thereof & bid in the sum of Three thousand dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of the Conditions of this decree, & all other debts to be settled in this suit. And the said R. R. Griffin, Commissioner so appointed, is desired to report to this Court, ~~the last~~ his proceedings herein, in order to a final decree.
