Crotwell by and to is hereby appointed a special Commissioner to sell the same - at auction in the town of Franklin after having duly advertised the same in at least four public places in the county, and in the Franklin Register and in some newspaper published in the City of Norfolk for thirty days immediately preceding the sale - and the following bond, to wit: one fourth in cash and the balance in one, two and three years, equal installments, the purchaser giving bond with sufficient personal security and the title to be retained till the final order of the Court. But the said Commissioner shall not proceed to act until he shall have accounted in the Clerk's Office of this Court before the Clerk thereof, and security in the penalty of four thousand dollars, and time for the faithful performance of the duties enjoined by this decree. All of the said ~~lots~~^{parts} or parcels of land are more especially described and indicated by a plat or diagram filed by the said Commissioner with their report, which said diagram is marked P. As to the lots or parts thereof the said proceeds therefrom are to be divided as follows, to wit: one half to the said John Paxton junior, one fourth to the said Jester Bost, and the other fourth to the said minor children of the said Henry B. Bost. And the said Jester Bost, in order to equalize the said division shall pay unto the minor children of the said Henry Bost, demands for sum of seventeen dollars and fifty cents (\$17.50 cents) - and to the said Jester Paxton junior ten dollars (\$10.00 cents). And the said Thomas J. Crotwell shall report to this Court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that the decree be enjoined till the first day of next term.
