And the said Court will report his proceedings to Court.

On this day this cause came on to be heard on the Complainant's bill, the answer of Mary R. Howell the answer of the infant defendants by J. C. Edwards Gon- ad. litem, with general replication thereto - and was argued by Counsel - on consideration whereof the Court doth as judge, order and decree that partition be made of the land of which Alexander Howell died seized - among the parties thereto entitled - viz: $\frac{1}{4}$ part thereof to E. D. Brown & wife, $\frac{1}{4}$ part thereof to J. J. King & wife, $\frac{1}{4}$ part to J. O. C. Howell and $\frac{1}{4}$ part to Alexander Howell and for the purpose of effecting said division, it is decreed that Luther R. Edwards, James Holmes & F. A. Borden be & they are hereby appointed Commissioners to allot the same - but if partition in their opinion be impracticable then they will report the same with their reasons - the real value of the lands with any other matters deemed pertinent by themselves or required by the parties.
