This day this Cause came on to be heard in the Hall of the Court.
Inasmuch, the Examination of witnesses and the report of Counsel,
On Consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, Order and decree,
that the parties Veronica Atkinson & Ch. of Atkinson be divorced
from bed and board, that the said Ch. of Atkinson be enjoined
and restrained from receiving or interfering with the infant
children of the said Veronica Atkinson, and that the Custody and
Control of the said children remain with their mother Veronica
Atkinson. That the said Ch. of Atkinson be also enjoined and
restrained from interfering in any manner with the custody of the
said Veronica Atkinson. The Court doth further decree that the
said Ch. of Atkinson pay the Plaintiff her Costs by her expenses
made in the prosecution of this suit. And nothing further
requiring expending to be done in this Cause, it is ordered
that the same be removed from the docket, but leave is given
to the parties to make application to the Court for such further
Orders as are authorized by Law. And it is also ordered that
a Copy of this decree be served upon the Defendant, Ch. of Atkinson.

Land devised to Mr. J. Herring, from year to year, until
