

expenses of the sale, which he will require in cash and apply in payment of said costs and expenses and that said Sheriff take of the purchaser of said land, two separate Bonds for the residue of said purchase money in equal sums, reserving the benefit of the Homestead exemption and with good personal security and payable to himself eight and sixteen months from and after the day of sale with interest from that day and contain the title to said land with further order of Court, and that said Sheriff before proceeding to sell said tracts of land, advertise the time, place and terms of the sale and the land to be sold by publication of the notice thereof once or twice for three consecutive weeks in the Suffolk Herald, a newspaper published in the Town of Suffolk, Virginia, and for at least thirty days previously to the sale by printed notices to be posted at said Court house door and at various conspicuous places in said County and in the neighborhood of said tracts of land, and that said Sheriff make report to Court of his proceedings under this decree, filing therewith said Bonds and all proper vouchers of payments in pursuance thereof.
