This day the cause came on again to be heard on the papers formally read and the report of Commissioner Tyler of Jethro Cobb administrator of H. V. Cobb's estate also an account of the actual and annual value of all the real estate of H. V. Cobb made pursuant to an order of this Court of the May term 1878 and to which report no exceptions have been filed and was agreed by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that the said report be confirmed and it appearing to the Court from the said accounts that there are no debts in the hands of Jethro Cobb Administrator of H. V. Cobb to pay the debts provided against the said estate and that the rents of the lands belonging to the heirs will pay the debts in four years. Therefore by consent of parties the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that unless Edward Cobb, Agnes S. Cobb, Richard S. Cobb, and Carrie F. Cobb the heirs at Law of H. V. Cobb shall pay the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars on or before the first of January 1879 to the creditors of H. V. Cobb who have proved their debts the account of Commissioner Tyler and the said sum to be distributed pro rata among the said creditors they all being of the same class the Sheriff of Southampton shall run out all the real estate of H. V. Cobb dead except that which has been allotted to the widow Elizabeth A. Cobb Taking bonds for the rent for year 1879 payable the 31st of December 1879 and it is further adjudge, ordered and decreed that Jethro Cobb settle a further account of his transactions as administrator of H. V. Cobb due before one of the Commissioners of this Court who will report the same to Court together with any matter demanded pertinent by himself or which may be required to be so stated by any of the parties interested, and that the said heirs at Law pay to to Wm B. Shanks attorney a fee of fifty dollars as a part of the cost of this suit.
