This Cause came on this day to be heard upon the bill of Exhibits, and the
enunciation of witnesses, & was argued by Counsel for Plaintiff.
On Consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, Order, and decree,
That the Marriage heretofore had & solemnized between the Defendant
John H. Pope of the Plaintiff Mississippi River, formerly Missions
Johns, shall be & it shall be hereby dissolved, and that the
said Mississippi River, be forever divorced from the said John H.
Pope, & all right title or interest of the said John Pope is to
be in the Estate or person of the said Mississippi River, whether
the said Estate be real or personal These premises forth, forever
Counsel & determine, & the said Mississippi River shall be at liberty
to marry again, and shall be restored to the Condition of a
single Woman, & all other rights attaching to such Condition.
The Court doth further adjudge, Order and decree, that the
female child of the Marriage, of the said John H. Pope &
Mississippi River, named Adeline Elizabeth Pope, shall remain in
the Care & Custody of the Mother of said Mississippi
River, and all the lawful power & authority of the said John H.
Pope, now the person & Estate of the said female child shall come
