 on a credit of one year and three years, the purchaser to give
 bonds with approved security carrying interest from the day of
 sale, and title retained for defered payments. But this claim

 ter into bond before the clerk of this court with approved
 security in the penalty of two hundred dollars, conditioned
 to faithfully execute this and any further decree in this

This day this cause came on to be further heard on the
 papers formerly read, the report of Commissioners Spring & others
 filed October 20th 1878 respecting partition of the Mill and
 land thence attached enforceable and recommending sale
 thereof and was argued by counsel. On consideration
 of no exceptions being filed to said report the same is
 hereby confirmed. And the Court doth adjudge, order
 and decree that J. P. Clemente and J. Price either one
 of whom may act as and they are hereby appointed special
 Commissioners for the purpose. That they sell to the highest
 bidder at Public Auction after twenty days public notice
 of time and place the Mill and land thence attached
 in the proceedings mentioned upon the following terms
 1/2 cash, balance on a credit of one & two years, equal
 annual instalments the purchaser to give bonds with
 approved security carrying interest from the day of sale
 and title retained for defered payments, subject to full
 bearing and valuing. The buying ground upon said land
 with growing trees to stand with privilege to cut from
 said land sufficient timber to enclose & keep enclosed the
