This cause came on this day to be again heard on the papers formerly read therein and on the Report of special Commissioner Joseph H. Urquhart being a Report of the sale of land made in pursuance of a decree of this Court pronounced at November Term thereof in the year 1878 in this cause and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth confirm the said Report to which no exceptions have been filed and doth adjudge order and decree that said Commissioner Joseph H. Urquhart receive of the Clerk of this Court who will deliver to him and take a receipt of him for the three Bonds of Robt. J. Kelly with Wm. Kelly and John White as his securities each for the sum of Two thousand one hundred and sixty six and ⁶⁶/₁₀₀ dollars fixed with his said Report and dated the 16th day of December 1878 and payable to himself one two and three years after the date thereof respectively with interest from date, and that he, said Commissioner, proceed to collect the principal of said Bonds at their maturity and all interest due thereon, or receive the same at any time before maturity of said Bonds should said obligors desire so to pay the same, and that said Commissioner with the money for said Bonds when collected or received as aforesaid together with the sum of \$40⁰⁰ in his hands as shown by his said Report pay first all unpaid costs of this cause and then pay first in full to M. A. B. Ridley & C. P. Ridley the Executors of Thos. Ridley the sum of \$4795.19 with interest
