Lindley Jr, as shown by the report of Commissioner John St. Deboile filed in this cause, the order of payment being in accordance with the respective priorities of said claims, and that said Commissioner Joseph W. Urquhart make report to Court of his proceedings under this decree, And the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that said Joseph W. Urquhart as special Commissioner aforesaid, make to said Robert J. Uxley a deed with special warranty in the usual form conveying to him the real estate purchased by him under proceedings had in this cause, after the principal of said bonds shall have been paid in full as aforesaid together with all interest due thereon, the said J.
