 & provisions not contemplated by the will of Eliza
 B. Urquhart & that said deed was made under
 a misapprehension of facts, it each ordered, order
 & decree that said deed be set aside and a new
 deed be executed by J. S. Morgan wife so as to convey
 said property upon the following trusts, that is
 that the said tract of land is conveyed to said
 A. B. Urquhart Trustee, his heirs & assigns, upon this
 trust; that he shall permit E. H. Urquhart his
 wife to occupy, possess & enjoy said tract of land
 free from all manner of charge & encumbrances
 on said A. B. Urquhart her said husband or any
 other husband hereafter to be taken, that upon
 this further Trust, that the Crops grown upon
 said land or proceeds of the sales of said
 Crops shall in no wise be subject to the debts
 of said A. B. Urquhart, nothing further appearing
 to be done in this case it is removed from the
 docket, with authority to be reinstated if the
 parties desire

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until tomorrow morning 10 o'clock.
