Barnes who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that purpose, do assign on allot to the several parties before named the respective shares before mentioned by metes & bounds and the said Commissioners if necessary are authorized to employ the services of a Competent Surveyor, And if partition cannot be conveniently made then the said Commissioners will report that fact to Court, and also whether the entire subject can be allotted to any interested party who will accept it and is willing to pay therefor to the other parties such sum as their interest therein may entitle them to - The said Commissioners will also report the Real value of the land with any other matters deemed pertinent by themselves or required by the parties.
