whereof the Court doth adjudge order & decree that unless the defendants in this cause or some one for them within 30 days from the date of this decree, pay to the plaintiffs the sum of \$800⁰⁰ with interest thereon from 10th Oct. 1878 till payment, the said Defendants their heirs & all persons claiming under them be and from thenceforth forever banned & foreclosed of and from all equity of redemption in a lot of land situated & being at Brauchville Dist. of Southampton County Va. bounded on North by the lands of Peter Ellis on the East by the lands of J. W. Harrison, on the South by the lands of Roanoke R.R. on the west by the lands of Peter Ellis the said lot containing $3\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre more or less, and has upon it a dwelling, Store House & Barn room and also the following personal property. One Gray mare Horse and furniture & 15 head of hogs, and in case of default in the payment of the sum of money and interest aforesaid that Geo. E. Beaton who is hereby appointed a special Commissioner for that purpose do after having duly advertised the time & place of sale, expose to sale on the premises at public auction to the highest bidder, the said lot of land on the following terms to wit: for cash, the balance on a credit of six months the purchaser to give bond with approved security carrying interest from day of sale the title to be retained till the whole of purchase money is paid, and that the said Court see the personal property aforesaid for cash. But the said Geo. E. Beaton is not to proceed to act under this decree until he shall have entered into Bond with sufficient security in the Clerk's Office of this Court in the penalty of \$2000⁰⁰ conditioned for the faithful discharge of his duties as such Commissioner and the said Court will report his proceedings to Court.

Ordered That the Court be adjourned until tomorrow morning nine o'clock.
