Joseph A. and L. A. Kindred, and secured by a Deed of Trust from Sally Neal to W.B. Shands trustee, was argued by Counsel, and it appearing to the Court upon the said report, and the deeds and the bonds therewith filed, that the investment has been made as directed by the Court under its decree of the November Term 1878, The Court doth adjudge order and decree that the same be reported to the Court as satisfactory of all debts claims and demands against him as executor of said Sally Neal died by the will of Mary E. Joseph A. and L. A. Kindred on account of his transactions as said Executor prior to Jan'y 1st 1874.
