This cause was again heard this day on the papers formerly read together with the Report of Commissioner Dylen which was duly filed on the 27th April 1879 to which there being no exceptions the Court confirming said Report doth adjudge order & decree that Esther R. Edwards, Isaac A. Kitchin, William Edwards, A. J. Webb & John Moore (any three of whom may act) be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners for the following purpose to wit: that the said Commissioner is acting all at or assign to Mrs Better M. Massenburg, widow of Wm. A. Massenburg dec^d one just and equal share in value of all of the real estate of which the said Wm. A. Massenburg died seized & possessed, to be held by her for and as her dower. The said Commissioner is acting shall all at or assign the said dower by metes and bounds and may employ if necessary a competent surveyor. The Court doth further order that one of the Commissioners of this Court take an account of debts still outstanding against the estate of the said Wm. A. Massenburg, if any, after duly advertising of the time & place and what is the absolute & annual rental value of the residence of the said real estate after the abatement of taxes to the said Mrs Better M. Massenburg, reporting any other accounts or matters deemed necessary by the said Commissioners or which may be required by any party interested to be stated.
