Wm. W. Briggs Sheriff of Southampton County, proceed
to rent out publicly one half of the real Estate
of which Elizabeth Little died seized and possessed
that is the lower plantation which lies adjoining
the three creeks collect the rents therefor annually
as they may fall due and out of the same pay
to James E. Sobrell surviving partner of Sobrell &
& Holmes the sum of two hundred dollars with
legal interest thereon from this day till paid which
it is agreed shall be in full satisfaction of all
claims and demands made in this suit and to
Fortunatus Dunn the sum of twenty dollars with like
interest from this day which shall be in full satis-
faction of the judgment fee \$15.00 which is mention-
ed in this suit - and the said Wm. W. Briggs shall
also pay out of the proceeds of said rents one half of
the legal costs accrued in this suit the other half of
said costs to be paid by the plaintiffs Sobrell & Holmes
& Dunn. And the said Briggs shall report his
proceedings annually to this Court in order to
