This day this cause came on to be again heard on
 the papers formerly read the report of Comm. Tyler filed
 Aug. 18th 1879, with the depositions of witnesses, and
 was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof
 and no exceptions being filed to said report, the same
 is hereby confirmed. And the Court doth further adjudge
 order and decree that F. P. Pope who is hereby
 appointed a Special Comm. for the purpose, sell the
 real estate in the proceedings mentioned upon the
 following terms to wit: one half cash, the balance
 on a credit of twelve & eighteen months the purchaser
 to give bonds approved security carrying interest
 from day of sale and the title to be retained for the
 deferred payments. But the said Comm. will not
 proceed to execute this decree until he shall have
 entered into bond before the Clerk of this Court in
 the penalty of \$2000. with security to be approved
 by him, conditioned to faithfully execute this and
 any further decree in this cause. And the said
 Comm. will report his proceedings to Court.
