This cause came on this day to be again heard on
the papers formerly read therein and on the Report of
Commissioner James R. Tyler filed on the first day of
October 1879 and was argued by counsel.
On consideration whereof the Court doth confirm the
said Report to which no exception has been filed and
doth adjudge order and decree that the land devised
to said Wm. S. Stephenson by Willome Stephenson
deceased as set forth in the first clause of the will of
said deceased duly proved and admitted to record
in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, Virginia on
the 17th day of December A. D. 1866 is by said will charged
with a "home and support" for said Catharine Stephenson
and Sally A. Eley daughters of said testator during their
single lives and that said land must furnish and
supply said "home and support" and that the estimate
and valuation thereof at fifty dollars a year as ascertained
by said Commissioner in his said Report based upon the
examinations of witnesses for said Catharine Stephenson
and Sally A. Eley respectively is a proper, adequate
and just estimate and doth adopt confirm and
allow the same. And it appearing to the Court by said
report that said "home and support" at the valuation
fixed as above amounts for said Catharine Stephenson
to the sum of \$609.75 and to a like sum for said Sally
A. Eley from the time the same accrued in the year
1870 to the first day of October 1879 the Court doth
adjudge order and decree that said Catharine Stephe-
son receive of said Wm. S. Stephenson said sum of \$609.75
with interest on \$487.50 part thereof from the first day of
October 1879 till paid and that said Sally A. Eley
