

recover a judgment of money of said Wm L. Stephenson with like interest on \$187.50 part thereof till paid and that said Catherine Stevenson and Sally A. Eley recover jointly of said Wm L. Stephenson their costs to be taxed by the Clerk of this Court in this behalf expended. And the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that said Wm L. Stephenson pay to said Catherine Stevenson and Sally A. Eley each the sum of \$50.00 on the first day of October 1880 and continuing so to pay the same so long as said Catherine Stevenson and Sally A. Eley shall remain single and unmarried, the same being for their said "Home and Support" annually out of said land. And in case of a failure of said Wm L. Stephenson sets so, the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that the Sheriff of Southampton County takes charge of and rents out said land annually until the further order of Court at public Auction before the Courthouse door of said County on the third Monday in November of each year commencing with the third Monday in November 1880 (that day being County Court day of said County) to the highest bidder taking off the renter's bond for the rent with good personal security and payable to himself two months after date and make report to Court thereof annually filing said bond with his report. Said land being a tract of land situated in said County about six miles from Zuni Station on the O. & R. R. and near Seacock Swamp and containing three hundred and fifty six acres more or less and bounded by the lands of M. W. Clayton S. J. Stephenson and others. And the Court doth further order that a copy of this decree be served upon said Wm L. Stephenson by the Sheriff of said County.
