This day the Court came on to be further heard on the papers presented, and the report of Charles Tyler filed Oct 28. 1879, the Report of William Briggs filed during the Term, & the petition of Dennis W. Williams & others, with affidavit of Johna Probert one of the Commissioners who were appointed by the Court to the widow of Warren Edwards ad. and was argued by Counsel, for Consideration thereof. No Exceptions being filed to the Report of Charles Tyler & William Briggs, the same are hereby confirmed. Upon the Court doth assign day, Friday Jan. 2nd 1880, that Mr. Briggs Sheriff of Southampton County, sell to the highest bidder, at public auction, the Undivided interest of Warren Edwards ad. in the Survey, Acers of Land as reported in Commissioner Tyler's Report, of Paul Quay. Upon the following terms, viz. half Cash, balance in four Months, the purchaser to give Bond with good Security, covering interest from day of Sale, & the title retained for deferred payments, & said Briggs will report his proceeds to Court.

The Court doth further come that the report of Commissioner allowing down to the widow of Warren Edwards, filed April 14th 1877, be set aside, & that Johna Probert, Jas. H. Strong and R. W. Rogers, be and they be and have appointed Commissioner to assign down to the said Widow, & in making said assignment, that the said Commissioner will determine the interest of said Warren Edwards ad. land at or near South Quay, at one hundred dollars. And the said Commissioner will report to Court. The Court doth further decree that W. W. Briggs, Sheriff of Southampton, rent out for the year 1880, all the lands of Charles Warren Edwards ad. seized, except what is assigned to James, and the rent to be paid by the donee, & report to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock.
