On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge orders  
 and decree that J. N. Schell be appointed a special  
 Commissioner for the following purpose to wit: That he sell at  
 Public Auction the reversionary interest of the infant  
 defendants Charles Thomas Doughtie & Virginia Doughtie  
 in the tract of land in the proceeding mentioned  
 and now held by Susan Knight as her Power, on the  
 following term to wit: One third Cash the balance  
 on a credit of one and two years taking bonds with suf-  
 ficient security bearing interest from date from the  
 purchasers and title retained till the whole of purchase  
 money is paid or the whole parcel or money may be  
 received in cash by the Commissioner tendered by the  
 purchaser after the sale. The said Commissioner shall sell the  
 said reversionary interest on some County Court  
 day after having duly advertised the same but  
 at not for a less sum than \$350. and if the said  
 reversionary interest shall be so sold for the sum  
 of \$350<sup>00</sup> or upward, the said Commissioner is hereby ordered  
 to pay the same over to the legally qualified  
 Guardian of said minor Defendants on the said
