This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers first filed and read and Edwin D. Turner having withdrawn his petition in this cause and consenting that a deed be made to the purchaser Robert D. Pope, and it being suggested that Edwin Turner one of the last defendants has departed this life since the last order entered in this cause and his estate having been committed to Wm. V. Briggs Sheriff of said county in the name of his administrator, and it appearing to the Court that the money due to him from the sale of this land should be equally divided among his surviving brothers and sisters, the Court doth adjudge, order, and decree, that W. V. Briggs withdraw the bond of \$1000 which by Robert D. Pope and John W. Sebrill from the papers in this cause and collect the same executing a deed with special warranty to Robert D. Pope the purchaser for the two tracts of land one containing 48 1/2 acres and the other 6 1/2 acres of land and divide the said sum along with the sum of \$13.75 its now in his hands into six equal parts and pay one sixth to Edwin D. Turner one sixth to Francis Garrison, one sixth to Virginia Turner, one sixth to Maria Turner, one sixth to Rebecca Britt and one sixth to the lawful guardian of William Turner and return his receipts going with his report to Court in or to a further decree
