 and L. N. Robinson filed a petition: 1880 to which report
 their being no exceptions the court doth hereby con-
 firm the same, and further order and decree that
 J. N. Seville be and he is hereby appoi-
 nted Special Commissioner for the following
 purpose to wit: That after having advertised the
 same in the Suffolk Examiner at one paper
 published in the Town of Suffolk once a week
 for four weeks and at three or more public
 places in the neighborhood for a like period he
 proceed to sell at public outcry on the premises
 the real estate in the proceeding mentioned
 on the following terms to wit: 1st in cash, the
 remainder in one and two years equal install-
 ments taking bonds from the purchaser with
 good personal security, bearing interest from date
