 adjudged, order and decree, that upon Willoughby Barr's  
~~deed~~ from the Clerk as to Willoughby Barr's at the 16<sup>th</sup>  
 of July 1877 to R. D. Griffith be set aside and that upon  
 Willoughby Barr's paying to Wm. A. Myrick the sum  
 of forty seven cents and interest and all the costs

 adjudge and decree that the Plaintiff recover  
 from the Defendants their costs by them in this  
 suit in this behalf expended.
