 adjudge, order and decree, that upon ~~Willoughby Batt's~~ ^{Willoughby Batt's}
 petition from the Clerk as to Willoughby Batt's of the 16th
 of July 1877 to R. D. Griffith be set aside and that upon
 Willoughby Batt's paying to Wm. A. Myrick the sum
 of forty seven cents and interest and all the costs
 and damages incurred by reason of the Deceasener's
 sale of the tract of forty seven acres of land lying
 near Newsome's Depot in Southampton and
 belonging one fourth to Robert D. Griffith, one fourth
 to John Paget and Milford Paget his wife and one
 fourth to Willoughby Batt or tendering the same to
 him, then that Wm. B. Shaver who is appointed a
 Special Commissioner for that purpose shall convey
 one individual half of the said tract of forty
 seven acres of land with special warranty to Willoughby
 Batt, and the said Special Commissioner
 is directed to report his proceedings to Court in
 order to a further decree and the Court doth further
 adjudge and decree that the Plaintiffs recover
 from the Defendants their costs by them in this
 suit in this behalf expended.

 J. W. Ridley and Bettie Ridley his wife by their
 Attorneys, and by leave of the Court filed their
 joint and separate answer to the said Bill and
 thereupon the Court doth appoint S. R. Edwards
