

agreement of Jos. B. Prince counsel for creditors and was agreed by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth sustain the exception taken by said defendants to said Report as to the item of \$1795.⁷² stated and reported by said Commissioner Dyer as an outstanding debt against the estate of W. W. Dwyer deceased in favor of Wm. C. Crocker as Executor of Wm. C. Crocker deceased and doth overrule the exceptions of said defendants to said report in other respects and being of opinion that said claims of \$1795.⁷² of said Wm. C. Crocker as Executor of Wm. C. Crocker deceased is barred by the statute of limitations and for other reasons is not a good, a valid claim against said W. W. Dwyer's estate, the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the same be not allowed against said W. W. Dwyer's estate. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that Jos. B. Prince, Commissioner, with the sum of \$1354.35 in his hands as appears by his Report filed in this cause on the 23rd day of August A. D. 1879⁷³ pay first all unpaid costs of this suit to be taxed by the Court of this Court, including to Wm. C. Crocker, Jos. B. Prince and William J. Kilby counsel for the Plaintiffs and Defendants, each a fee of \$100. and pay the residue of the funds in his hands and distribute the same pro rata to and among the creditors of said W. W. Dwyer, whose claims are allowed in this cause, to be settled and paid at the rate of sixty per cent in full of the principal and interest thereof as per Agreement of Jos. B. Prince Counsel for creditors filed in this cause the 6th day of November A. D. 1880. and this cause is continued &c.
